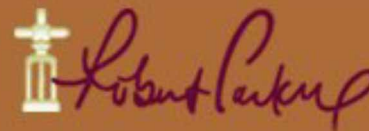




# ROBERT PARKER - 2014 PEÑALOLÉN AZUL 2010

### 2010 Penalolen Azul

A Proprietary Blend Dry White Table wine from Chile, Maipo, Chile

The 2010 Azul is Cabernet Sauvignon complemented with small percentages of Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot from a young vineyard planted with a massal selection from Domus Aurea, half of which is planted with rootstock and the other half planted directly. The wine is aged for 20 months in oak barrels. There is an extended maceration and the grapes ferment with indigenous yeasts. It has a ripe nose of tobacco, spiced plums, cassis and hints of paprika. It has a medium to full-bodied palate with some dusty tannins and a light dryness that detracts from the overall positive sensation. This is only the second vintage of this wine, as the vineyards were planted very recently. Drink 2015-2018.

Penalolen is a separate company, but the wines are vinified in the facilities of Clos Quebrada de Macul, so wines from two different vineyards are produced in the same winery.
